
The Circleville Pumpkin **Show Community Band**



In 1979, Mr. Gary Dean was approached by some of his former students to start a band for people out of school. As Mr. Dean's work schedule at the time had him out of the area, Mr. Drexel Poling (a former Band director at Teays Valley) would step in to help direct the "Hometown" band. In 1982 Mr. Clifford Kerns took over the directorship and remained in that position until 2006. At present David Winner is the director.

The band supports and is supported by Pumpkin Show, Inc. Pumpkin Show provides our practice facility and at various times provides us with monetary gifts. We perform three concerts and are in two parades during the fall event. But that is only a small part of our commitment and contributions to the community. We also sponsor the local Merry Tuba Christmas program, put on annually in November.
