



Pumpkin Show Band Marks 18th Year

The Circleville Pumpkin Show Community band will perform four times during the upcoming Circleville Pumpkin Show.

The Band, directed by Mr. Clifford L. Kerns will play two concerts, on Wednesday and again on Friday on the West Main Street Platform. Both concerts are scheduled to start at approximately 6:30 p.m.

The band will also participate in two parades, on Wednesday Night, and again on Thursday night.

The band roster contains 72 names, with an average of 50 participating in engagements.

This year marks the 18th consecutive year that the band has performed in the Pumpkin Show. On an average year, the band will perform an average of 15

times. (Concerts and/or parades).

Band members consist of men and women of all ages from Junior High School to Senior Citizens, and come from all over central Ohio: Ashville, Canal Winchester, Lancaster, Chillicothe, Waverly, Kingston, Laurelville, Amanda, Stoutsville, Orient, Columbus, Lockbourne and of course, Circleville.

The band rehearses each Tuesday, from 7:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. in their own Practice Hall, located at the rear of the Pumpkin Show Offices on East Franklin Street. (Beside the Police Station). Anyone desiring to join the band should attend the first Tuesday night practice they can make.

The band's next concert will be a Christmas Concert to be performed on Sunday, Dec. 14th.
