Our Speaker...

Dr. Douglas Carter and his wife Winnie grew up in Bacon County, Georgia. They were appointed missionaries by World Gospel Mission in 1963 and served as missionaries to the American Indians in Arizona for more than sixteen years. In 1980 Dr. Carter became president of Circleville Bible College where he served nine years helping prepare men and women for Christian service.

From 1989 until he joined EQUIP in 1996, Dr. Carter served as vice president at World Gospel Mission, an interdenominational mission agency with 330 career missionaries sharing the gospel in twenty-four nations. Dr. Carter has ministered in more than thirty nations.

Dr. Carter presently is Executive Vice President of Public Affairs for EQUIP (Encouraging Qualities Undeveloped in People), founded by Dr. John Maxwell, a nonprofit ministry which provides training and resource materials for Christian leaders around the world. Doug and Winnie reside in Suwanee, Georgia, northeast of Atlanta. They are the parents of three children - Angie, Eric and Jason.

The Preaching Mission Theme, developed by Dr. Carter, is *"In His Image."* The themes for our four worship services are as follows:

"The Broken Vessel"	Matthew 27:3-10
"The Restored Vessel"	Ephesians 2:1-10
"The Filled Vessel"	Acts 4:8-13 & Acts 4:29-31
"The Serving Vessel"	John 12:23-26
