

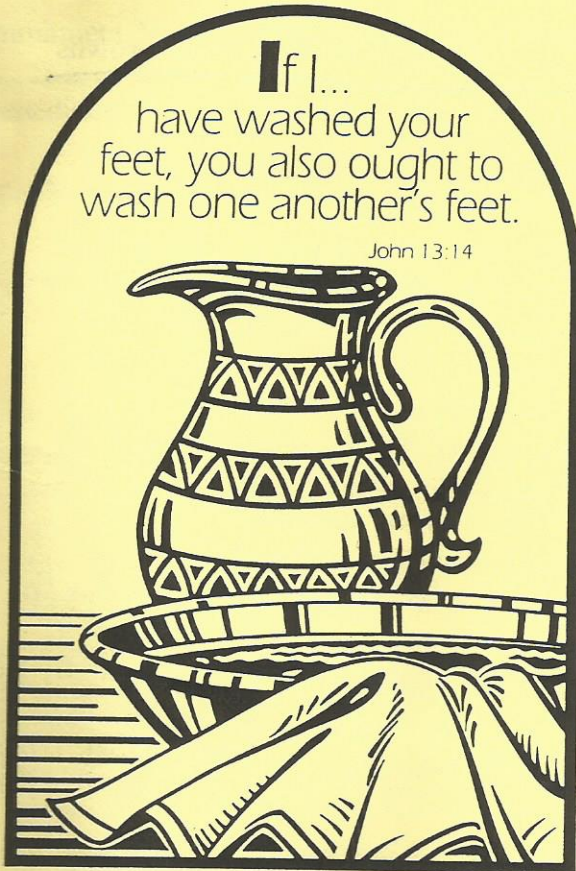

OUR SPEAKER...

According to The Rev. Dr. Douglas A. Dunderdale, who was ordained by Los Angeles Presbytery in 1954, "*Jesus Christ continues to call me and to challenge me to a life of obedience and servanthood.*" He has served in the Pittsburgh, PA area for most of his ministry and retired in 1996.

Currently, The Rev. Dunderdale is moderator of Pittsburgh Presbytery, a regional governing body of the Presbyterian Church, USA. He also serves as assistant to the ministers for the First Presbyterian Church, Pittsburgh.

The preaching mission, which includes clergy and lay persons in the planning, mirrors Dr. Dunderdale's philosophy. "*My experience in ministry has convinced me that the church must be returned to lay people. The demands placed upon the church are too complex and over powering to be answered by a clergy-dominated church. Lay people must be challenged, educated and equipped to do the work of ministry in the world. Now to do that will be the challenge to the church in the years to come.*"

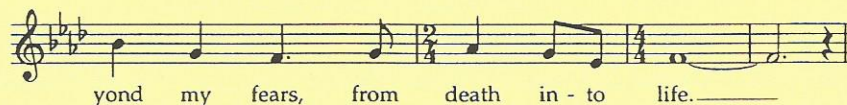
A STAFFED NURSERY for young children (infants through 3 years) is provided downstairs in the Christian Education wing for your convenience. Ask an usher to direct you.
