Please note contents of this bulletin..it has to do with our activities in the month of August, as it stands as of now.

Sunday, August 17th Concert on Court House Square VIII at 6:30 in the evening on the steps of the County Court House.

Monday, August 18th at 6:30 in the evening at Williamsport. More info on this later.

Tuesday, August 19th our Annual Family Picnic at the Circle K Ranch. In case you have forgotten, or do not know, Cliff's Ranch is located at 26525 Gay-Dresbach Rd. You, your spouse and kids are invited.(Games such as Volley Ball, fishing, horse back riding) Bring your own table service and a covered dish as follows: Band members whose last names start A thru G bring salads..H thru O bring deserts..P thru Z bring main course foods with the exception of meet and drinks which Cliff will provide. Here's the directions to the Circle K Ranch....Lake Rt 56 East to Kingston Pike. Turn Right on Kingston Pike, cross thru the 4-way stop that has a Marathon Station on the corner. Go to 1st road (Gay-Dresbach Rd) and turn left. Then take 1st road to the right to the Circle K Ranch which is located on the Right hand side. As in all concerts, please try to arrive half-hour early so as to be set up and ready to start at concert time as listed above.
